

## SUPPLY LIST – ALLA PRIMA PAINTING CLASSES

**Oil Paint** - I use Winsor & Newton or Gamblin brand. You can buy another brand if you like.

Please include the following colors (DON'T buy hues!!!) if you have a different choice of colors you can bring them.

- Titanium white
- Cadmium yellow light
- Cadmium yellow medium
- Cadmium red light
- Alizarin crimson
- Ultramarine blue,
- 1980 phthalo blue
- Burnt umber
- Ivory black

I sometimes add permanent rose to this list.

**Disposable palette** - any size disposable paper palette for color mixing.

**Palette knife** - to clean and mix the paint

**Rags or paper towels** - to clean brushes

**Baby wipes** - to clean after painting

**Mineral spirits:** I highly recommend Gamsol by Gamblin. Bring a jar or paint brush cleaner (has a grate at the bottom).

**Sketchbook, drawing pencil and eraser**

**Medium:** Winsor & Newton Liquin gel or linseed oil.

**Brushes:** please bring some flats or brights in varying sizes, in addition to what you normally use! (I recommend Silver brush Bristol synthetic - brights sizes 4, 6, and 8, size 2 filbert for drawing. It is easy to clean.)

**View Finder:** Purchasing a plastic view finder from an art supply store is a great, small investment. A tool I use daily.

**Canvases or other painting surfaces:**

canvas panels (3-4), or any inexpensive painting surface 8x10 or 9x12.

I USE AMPERSAND GESSOBORD 1/8" THICK. I really like the surface of it. We use one canvas for each class.

I buy through [dickblick.com](http://dickblick.com) or Jerry's Artarama. You can use Plaza or Michael's.

**Easel:** Standing easels will be provided.

### NOTE FOR ACRYLIC PAINTERS

**Paint:** Bring all the primary and secondary colors.
