Background and Instructions

Falls Church Arts is a recognized 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization founded in 2003. With a stated mission to “ensure the arts are an essential part of the cultural environment,” Falls Church Arts has since inception focused on the visual arts, bringing exhibition opportunities and the chance to learn, share, and grow. We have dedicated exhibition space at 700-B West Broad Street and offer classes, workshops, and dialogue groups at that same location. Our scholarship efforts are a new offering of the organization and are meant to recognize and encourage those who display an early dedication to making art.

The student is submitting an application to Falls Church Arts as a hopeful recipient of an artistic merit scholarship award. As part of the student’s application, we ask that a selected art instructor tell the review committee about the student’s work, interest in the creative process, and any efforts made to incorporate their art into the artistic community in particular or the community as a whole. A part of the application includes the student’s submission of images representing their best work, so we look to you, as the student’s selected instructor, to provide insight that may not be obviously seen in the images presented.
